NSCM Trip to Vermont

January 27 - February 3, 2024

There is still one room available for anyone interested in this ski trip. Vermont is well-known as a fabulous place to cross-country ski. We will be near the lovely Green Mountains, from which Vermont gets its name. Here is your opportunity to experience the beauty of Vermont in winter. The trip will consist of eight days and seven nights, with opportunity to ski on six days.

We plan to stay at the Comfort Inn Trolley Square near Rutland see here. The rooms include TV, refrigerator, microwave, etc. The hotel has a pool and there is a restaurant next door.

The cost of the trip should be about \$1,000 for members and \$1,100 for non-members although the prices may change. This includes air fare from Chicago's O'Hare airport to Burlington, VT, rental car for every 3 people and lodging.

Minocqua Ski Trip

Friday, February 9 - Sunday, February 11, 2024

There is still plenty of room on the bus for you to join us for great skiing at Minocqua Winter Park, just named the Number 1 Cross Country Ski Resort in the country by USA Today.

MWP has 86 km of meticulously groomed and scenic ski trails as well as 15 miles of snowshoe trails, and continues to make improvements to the trails and facilities. A café in the chalet serves a variety of food, and homemade soups. The ski shop, which has expanded into a new addition, has all the latest ski gear, waxes, and clothes, and rents skis and snowshoes.

Out on the trails, you'll find the Tea House and three fire pits with shelters to gather with friends while skiing or snowshoeing.

We plan to ski at Nine Mile Forest near Wausau on the way up, with 30 km of ski trails, 11 km of snowshoe trails, and a large chalet with ski rentals.

Accommodations are at the AmericInn in downtown Minocqua with a swimming pool, sauna, whirlpool, free continental breakfast, and a microwave and refrigerator in each room.

Our five-hour bus ride from Milwaukee is divided by a mid-day stop at Nine Mile Forest near Wausau, with 30 km of both skating and striding ski trails and 11 km of snowshoe trails. The chalet offers ski rentals.

We'll stay at the Quality Inn hotel in Ironwood. Some restaurants are within walking distance of the hotel, and there are more dining options in nearby downtown Hurley. Saturday's group dinner will be at the Elk & Hound Restaurant on the Gogebic Country Club grounds in Ironwood. Expect an unforgettable evening!

Bus Trips Now Are for NSCM Members Only

To go on Nordic Ski Club of Milwaukee bus ski trips up north, participants must be club members. That is a change made to NSCM policy by the board of directors at its December 11, 2023, meeting.

In the past, we allowed non-members to participate in trips at a higher price. Since our current membership fee is low -- \$25 for individuals -- it makes sense for trip participants simply to join the club instead of paying a higher trip price. And one set of pricing makes it easier for trip leaders.

Also, please make sure you have paid your dues, and signed the club's liability waiver, before you go on a trip or you won't be allowed on the trip.

If it Snows, We Go

If you think you might be watching weather conditions this winter with an eye toward chasing skiable snow either during the week or on weekends, consider being the "point" or "contact" person for a "pop up" carpool type ski event. Contact Paul Keber at 262-547-4827 or pkeber@milwpc.com to discuss what communications would be needed and how you could put this event together in a very short period of time.

The idea here is to make this an easy way to coordinate a carpool-like trip to a ski destination that involves one or more overnight stays. Members would be responsible for their own transportation and lodging arrangements, but could coordinate to ski together, have one or more meals together, lodge at the same hotel, and possibly carpool, but without advanced coordination required.

Think destinations like: Nine Mile Forest in Wausau; Iola and/or Standing Rocks (just east of Stevens Point); Moccasin Lake and Jack Lake near Antigo; Black River State Forest near Black River Falls; Minocqua, etc. There are lots of options, all depending on where it snows. If this is of interest to you, let Paul know.
