The earliest opportunity to sign up for 2023-2024 NSCM bus ski trips is at the in-person registration on Friday, October 13 beginning at 7:00 pm, during the membership meeting. Ski-trip flyers are available on the club website and were in a September email sent to members. https://www.facebook.com/ Nordic-Ski-Club-of-Don't mail in reservation forms if you plan to sign up at the in-person registration.

Covid-19 vaccinations for bus ski trip participants are no longer required, but everyone is encouraged to keep up to date with the latest booster.

To prepare your registration, complete the reservation form for each ski trip and include a separate check payable to NSCM for the deposit amount. If you want to have the "trip letter" mailed to you, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped, business-size envelope with each reservation. Otherwise, the "trip letter" will be emailed to you.

Note that "four-to-a-room" means that there are four people and two beds in a room, with two people sharing each bed.

At the October in-person registration and meeting, one member of a household membership can bring all the reservation forms for their household. You can bring reservation forms for others who cannot attend the meeting. The signup priority will remain the same as in previous years. It **Contact Us:** is listed in the Ski-trip Reservation Policy of the "Important Facts For Ski Trip Reservations" document that can be found on the NSCM website Events page.

Online ski-trip registration opens on Saturday, October 14. Online reservations require payment of the total amount if you elect to pay online. You can also mail a check to the trip leader for the deposit amount. Online registration is generally available until 1 week prior to the departure date or until the trip fills.
