2024 Winter Ski Trips

Flyers for the 2024 Wisconsin/Upper Michigan Nordic Ski Club of Milwaukee bus ski trips will New memberships or arrive via email in mid-September. Early access to the trip flyers means you'll have lots of time before the October 13 signup meeting to review trip details and decide which ones to register for.

The ski trips with their two-per-room member early bird prices are as follows:

Friday, February 9 - Sunday, February 11: Minocqua Winter Park, WI - \$346

Friday, March 1 - Sunday, March 3: ABR Trails, Ironwood, MI - \$332

At its June 2023 meeting, the Nordic Ski Club of Milwaukee board voted to no longer require Covid-19 vaccinations for bus ski trip participants, although everyone is encouraged to keep up to date with the latest booster. Covid and the Club

Covid is not gone. In fact, Wisconsin had a spike in Covid outbreaks in July 2023. Many Nordic Ski Club of Milwaukee members are in the older age group that is more likely to have serious symptoms if they get Covid-19. And yet most of our members indicate that they have been vaccinated.

NSCM strongly recommends but is not requiring that members get the new Covid-19 booster shots this fall when they're available. The U.S. Centers for Disease Control also recommends flu shots. And you may want to consider vaccinating for RSV, a virus that is showing up in seniors. At its June 2023 meeting, the NSCM board voted to no longer require Covid-19 vaccinations for bus ski-trip participants. However, the board is continuing this policy:

Participants who get sick in the days before the ski trip or on the day of the trip are still required to cancel. You will be refunded all recoverable costs of bus trips. Please do not expose other trip participants to flu, Covid, colds or other contagious diseases.

The Nordic Ski Club of Milwaukee (NSCM) continues to follow recommendations by the Centers for Disease Control and Wisconsin authorities regarding Covid-19 safety. Know that your participation in any event is at your own risk. Before attending any NSCM outing or event, please check with the event leader. Use good judgment and continue to keep us all safe.
